

Women of the South High School Scholarship Application

Women of the South was founded in April, 1995. The purpose of our non-profit organization is to provide higher educational opportunities to women in the south metropolitan area. Scholarships will be awarded to high school senior women from south Oklahoma City and Moore. Women of the South will award \$1,000 scholarships, \$500 each semester.

Women of the South will evaluate applications from the following schools: Southeast High School, Capitol Hill High School, U.S. Grant High School, Westmoore High School, Moore High School, and Western Heights High School. Grade point must be 2.5 or above. The recipients of this award will be determined on the basis of academic achievement, honors, activities and financial need. To be eligible, students must be first-time entering freshmen at an in state college or university, beginning classes in the fall following their senior year of high school. (The scholarship will be paid directly to the state college or university through the Bursar's office.)

Scholarships will be continued for the second semester providing the recipient:

1. Maintains a grade point of 2.5
2. Provides a copy of the first semester transcript.
3. Provides a written statement addressing progress made in college work, her program for the future, and the meaning of a college education. Upon the receipt of this information, the remainder of the scholarship will be issued.

The completed application, with supporting documents and a certified high school transcript (showing 7 semesters), must be postmarked by February 28 each year. Incomplete applications will NOT be considered.
